Montgomery County, Virginia – Montgomery County Clerk of Circuit Court Erica Williams reminds citizens of the importance of requesting passports early for the busy travel season.

If you will be traveling in less than four weeks and need a passport, the Passport Agency recommends paying the expedited fees and overnight return fee to avoid any delays in processing your passport application. Current turnaround times are estimated at four weeks. Please remember, when applying for a passport in the Clerk of Circuit Court's office, you do not need an appointment but you must apply Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The Clerk's office is located at 1 E. Main St., Ste. B5, Christiansburg. They can be reached at 382-5760.
