



**Mountain View Humane announces
Pit Bull/Pit Bull Mix Spay/Neuter Service Grant**

Christiansburg, VA - Mountain View Humane, The Waldron-Ricci Spay Neuter Clinic, has received a \$5,000 grant from the Animal Farm Foundation, Inc. to help 100 Pit Bull or Pit Bull mix owners spay and neuter their pets for \$23.



Nineteen Pit Bulls are currently scheduled to have surgery or have already had surgery through this program, including Linkin. Linkin – pictured left - is the pet of Curtis Hutton of Max Meadows.

Mountain View Humane asks bully breed owners to call 540.382.0222 today to schedule their dog to be spayed or neutered and for more information. Reduced fee surgeries are by appointment only and space is limited. Owners must show proof of current rabies vaccination or their pet can be vaccinated at the time of surgery for \$10. Other vaccinations and services will be available at the time of surgery. While these funds are reserved to serve Pit Bull/Pit Bull mixes, all surrounding communities are served by the clinic and free transportation is also available from various locations throughout Southwest Virginia and West Virginia.
