DON TODORA RECOGNIZED FOR OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO COUNTY

Montgomery County, Virginia • The Montgomery County Board of Supervisors recently passed a resolution recognizing Donald D. Todora, who has been named the 2012 Virginia Water System Operator of the Year by the Virginia Rural Water Association (VRWA).

“Don can always be counted upon to assist in any MCPSA water operation at any time. His dedication to MCPSA water operations has made it the success that it is today,” noted the resolution approved by the Board of Supervisors.

“This is a very high honor because of the number of utilities in Virginia,” said Public Service Authority (MCPSA) Director Bob Fronk. “Don helps ensure the authority stays compliant with the complex regulations governing water quality and sewage treatment. He also has brought a new level of efficiency and innovation to operations. As an example, he devised a cost-effective leak detection system that has saved thousands of gallons of water as water lines age over time.”

The Virginia Department of Health’s recent annual inspection report also commended the PSA on “continuing efforts to improve the maintenance and operation of the waterworks as well as having an active asset management program.”

An Operations Specialist, Todora joined the PSA as a full-time employee on May 1, 1990, and has supervised water operations for nearly 20 years. He also conducts all training programs for staff members. He is a Class 3 Water Treatment Operator.

The PSA provides water to 10 community systems and sewage treatment to 10 systems in rural Montgomery County.
