STORMWATER ENGINEER IS ANNOUNCED

Montgomery County, Virginia • County Administrator Craig Meadows has named Douglas E. Burton, P.E., the county's new Director of Engineering and Regulatory Compliance starting June 9. He will be responsible for developing and administering the county's new stormwater management program, regulatory compliance and engineering programs. His duties will also include supervising the building inspections office.

"We are very pleased to have Doug's experience and background to help us implement our new stormwater management responsibilities," Meadows said. "His knowledge and customer service will be a great fit for this challenging role."



Burton has served as an area land use engineer for the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) since 2011. As VDOT's liaison for land development and engineering projects, he has worked closely with local officials in Montgomery, Pulaski and Giles counties. In this capacity, he also partnered with local officials to process rezoning requests and comprehensive plan amendments, administered quality control of permits and generated construction plans, contract documents and budget reports.

Burton has a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from Virginia Tech. He is also licensed as a professional engineer and designated as a land surveyor in training in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

From 2007 to 2011, he worked as a project manager for Lumsden Associates P.C. in Roanoke, Va. His development design duties included preparation of plans for erosion and sediment control, stormwater management and storm drains.

Previously, he worked first as a project engineer for the Roanoke County Utility Department and then as a civil engineer for Roanoke County where he participated in the creation of a new stormwater management manual and supervised code compliance inspectors.

Burton also was employed as a transportation engineer for VDOT from 1999 to 2004 and began his career as a land surveyor for various consulting firms.
