



MONTGOMERY COUNTY PUBLISHES FY2010 ANNUAL REPORT

Montgomery County, Virginia – Montgomery County has published its Fiscal Year 2010 Annual Report on the County's web site, www.montgomerycountyva.gov.

The report provides an overview of the County's accomplishments during the fiscal year from July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010.

"Montgomery County faced tremendous challenges during Fiscal Year 2010," said Board Chair Annette Perkins. "Declining local revenues and reduced funding from the State were dominant issues as the County absorbed funding losses through freezing vacant positions, delaying purchases and other cost-cutting measures."

The County's annual report is written in an easy-to-read style, with bullet points and short updates on County programs and projects such as:

- Approving rezoning requests for retail, office and residential projects in the 177 Corridor
- Increasing the income limit for exemption from or deferral of real estate taxes for the elderly and disabled
- Launching newly redesigned web sites for the County and Economic Development
- Rebroadcasting of Board meetings on the web and Comcast WCOM 190

The annual report also highlights grants and partnerships enabling the County to leverage resources, reduce costs and improve services, including public safety, parks and recreation and social services. Other highlights include ground breakings for a new Courthouse and two elementary schools to serve Price's Fork and Eastern Montgomery.
