



ALICE JONES SWORN IN AS COMMISSIONER OF THE REVENUE

Montgomery County, Virginia – Chief Deputy Commissioner Alice Jones was sworn in Thursday as Commissioner of the Revenue by Circuit Court Judge Robert Turk. She succeeds Sharon Gilbert, who announced her retirement effective Oct. 1.



Jones is a graduate of Smithdeal-Massey Business College in Richmond and has a degree in accounting. She worked at the Medical College of Virginia for four years.

Jones began her career working for the Montgomery County Public Schools. In October 1978, she started working in the Commissioner of the Revenue's office as a Deputy II in the real estate department. Jones became the Chief Deputy in January 2004.

"My office will continue to provide the same dedicated service to all citizens that they deserve," Jones said. "The citizens will be helped in the same timely and courteous manner that they have been provided in the past."

Gilbert's term expires Dec. 31, 2011. Jones said she plans to campaign for the commissioner's seat prior to the November 2011 election.
