



COUNTERFEIT DETECTION SYSTEM IN TREASURER'S OFFICE

Montgomery County, Virginia – Montgomery County's Treasurer W. Richard Shelton announced today that a new counterfeit detection system is now in place in his office.

The system uses ultraviolet and light emitting diode (LED) lights to detect security strips, watermarks and magnetic ink found in all paper currency.

With the rising circulation of counterfeit money, Shelton said this system is needed to help protect the County from receiving fake bills.
