Montgomery County, Virginia – Montgomery County Circuit Court Clerk Erica Williams has received Certified Circuit Court Clerk status from the Weldon Cooper Center for Public Service at the University of Virginia. Attaining certification requires that Circuit Court Clerks prove competency and hours of service in four areas: continuing education, service to the Court Clerks Association, the presentation of education/information to the public and experience as a Circuit Court Clerk.
