CLOSED MEETING

A closed meeting was held in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act for discussion, consideration or interviews of prospective candidates for assignment or appointment to the Parks and Recreation Commission and Planning Commission.

DELEGATION

- Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) – the Board of Supervisors was updated on area VDOT projects.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

- Ordinance Amendment – tax exemption and deferrals for the elderly and disabled – proposal to increase income limits
- Ordinance Amendment – Joint Tourism Program Agreement – proposal to clarify the roles of the operating board and Tourism Director

PUBLIC ADDRESS

Three speakers addressed the Board about the Nov. 6 General Election; all comments reflected a positive experience. Four speakers spoke to the Board concerning needed maintenance and repair at Christiansburg High School.

- Supervisor Chris Tuck presented evidence to the Board of the needed Christiansburg High School repairs due to safety concerns. He made a motion to support the high school maintenance by designating \$400,000 for repairs. The motion passed with a vote of 7-0.
