#### CLOSED SESSION

A closed session was held for discussion concerning a prospective business or industry: Projects 2014-006 and 2014-017; discussion or consideration of the acquisition or disposition of real property: Alleghany Springs and Mid-County; and discussion of candidates for appointment: Community Services Board, Parks and Recreation Commission and Planning Commission.
